ConnectHome Dauphin County Overview



Purpose:

The Housing Authority of the County of Dauphin is pleased to offer the opportunity for residents ages 11-18 to receive a tablet with internet access at no charge. These tablets are intended to be used to assist in school assignment, extracurricular activities and other educational functions.

Criteria:

To be eligible for a tablet, applicants must be a resident of one of the 16 sites owned and operated by the Housing Authority of the County of Dauphin. This requires the applicant to be on the lease and listed as a dependent. All residents aged 11-18 are eligible to apply, although, only one tablet per household will be awarded. Tablets will come pre-loaded with educational applications and parental controls.

Guidelines:

Tablets will be awarded on a rolling basis. Applicants must submit a full application packet to the Housing Authority. **Program participants will be required to submit their GPA to the Housing Authority at time of application and twice per year, in January and June**. In order to stay on the program, the participant's GPA must increase or remain stable. If the GPA decreases in two (2) consecutive reporting periods or more, the participant will forfeit the tablet to the Housing Authority.

Once a tablet has been award to a participant, it will remain with that student until they age out of the program or they fail to comply with the GPA requirement. After a participant graduates from high school, the participant can keep the tablet, but the Housing Authority will discontinue payment of the service.

Program participants will be required to sign additional terms and conditions at the time that they receive the tablet. The program will continue as funding allows. If funding is not available program participants will have the option to keep the tablet and service with a payment agreement with the Housing Authority.

Deadline:

Applications will be taken on a rolling basis. Applications can be submitted via email to kkelly@dauphinhousing.org or by mail or hand-delivery to 501 Mohn Street, Steelton, PA 17113.
